She presented slides showing what she referred to as bad and good days. Her slides which she referred to as 5 good days show numerous flyovers and turns by aircraft in the 5th Street and Harbor area. The Oxnard Shores Mobile Home Park is situated on 5th Street between Harbor and Mandalay Beach Road. Those types of days are not good days for residents of this Park.
